

MAYORAL PROCLAMATION NO. 04-09-16

Mayoral Proclamation Dissolving Evacuation Area to Reflect Current Flooding Conditions

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2016 the Cedar Rapids City Council adopted Resolution No. 1267-0916 which among other things declared a state of emergency in Cedar Rapids due to flooding conditions, and

WHEREAS, Iowa Code Section 372.14 (2016) provides for the Mayor to take certain actions during emergency conditions, and

WHEREAS, said Resolution also authorized the Mayor to take certain actions during the emergency including the establishment of a curfew, and

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2016, Ron Corbett, Mayor of the City of Cedar Rapids issued Mayoral Proclamation 01-09-16 establishing curfew hours within areas for which evacuation orders were given, and


WHEREAS, on September 28, 2016, Ron Corbett, Mayor of the City of Cedar Rapids issued Mayoral Proclamation 02-09-16 which changed the area subject to evacuation and curfew hours due to a change of the flooding conditions, and

WHEREAS, although the emergency has not ended, the flooding conditions have subsided to the point where the evacuation area can be dissolved and there is no further need for curfew hours.

NOW THEREFORE, Ron Corbett, Mayor of the City of Cedar Rapids, hereby proclaims as follows:

1. All existing evacuation and curfew orders are hereby terminated effective immediately.
