

# \*NEW\* Season Passes For Swimming Pools And Aquatic Centers


## Valid May 20 - September 2, 2024

Passes provide admission to Open, Family, Adult, Lap Swims, and Water Exercise as age appropriate. Schedules for pools, programs, and water features may vary. Go to [CRREC.org](http://CRREC.org) for updates.

### New Season Passes - What Changed?

The family pass previously was for two adults and up to four children. The new family pass will be for two people (one must be a parent or guardian) and will cost less. (See the blue box below.) Each additional family member can be added for \$30. All family members are still required to live in the same household.

New passes and last year's (2023) pass renewals may be purchased online. You have the option to have your pass mailed to you for an additional fee of \$3. You may also purchase passes in person at the locations and times below:

**BUY PASSES ONLINE!** Go to [CRREC.org](http://CRREC.org).

**GO** to Northwest Recreation Center, 1340 11th Street NW, or City Services Center (CSC), 500 15th Avenue SW, or any of the outdoor pools when they are open.

Pictures for season pass cards are required. (See box above for locations and times.)

► **Need New or Replacement Pass Cards?**

**GO** to Northwest Recreation Center or City Services Center (CSC) for new or replacement pass card photos or go to any outdoor pool when it is open.

**NANNY PASS (AGE 16+)**

Get your sitter a pass for when he/she takes your kids to the pool. The family sponsoring the nanny must have a family pass. The Nanny pass can be added at any time. (Designate "Nanny Pass" on the Season Pass form.) The pass, for sitters ages 16 and up, may only be used when the sitter is attending the pool with the kids. ### Financial Assistance Program: RecAssist -

**SEASON PASS RULES**

- You must present your pass to enter the pool.
- Passes are non-transferable and non-refundable.
- Replacement cards may be purchased for \$5 if cards are lost or stolen.
- Passes may be revoked for pool infractions and misuse with no refunds.
- Individuals who are immediate family members and who live at the same residence are eligible for a family pass.
- Nanny Pass must be purchased as part of a family pass. Nanny must be at least 16 years old. A special pass card will be issued. The pass can only be used when the nanny attends pool with the children. Designate "Nanny" on the Season Pass Form.

You may be asked at any time for verification that your family meets eligibility requirements. Misrepresentation could result in loss of passes.

Summer Punch Passes**

Passes provide admission to Open, Family, Adult, Lap Swims, and Water Exercise as age appropriate. Schedules for pools, programs/water features may vary. (See page 50-51.)

Punch passes may be used by an individual, a group, or transferred to another person for any age appropriate public swim and water exercise class. No photo required. Passes expire on the 20th punch.

Purchase passes online, by phone, or in person at the Northwest Recreation or City Services Centers, or the outdoor pools when they are open. **\$87 Non-refundable**

**PUBLIC SWIM  
FACILITY CLOSING  
POLICY**

Pools and aquatic centers may open late or close early for the following reasons:

- Air temperature below 70 degrees (Lap Swim: air temperature below 60 degrees)
- 20 people or less in the facility for a period of one hour (50 people or less at Noelridge and Cherry Hill)
- Lightning/severe storm in area
- Mechanical problems
- Poor water quality
- Special events/situations
- Darkness
- Maximum bather limit reached (When pool reaches capacity, patrons may be turned away and referred to another facility)
- Other reasons deemed necessary by the Cedar Rapids Parks & Recreation Department
